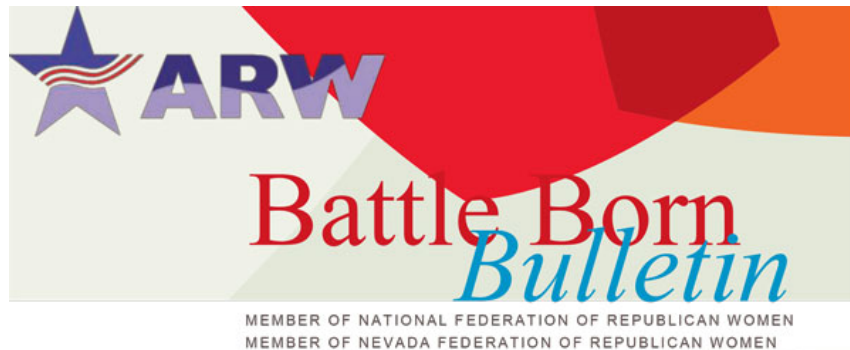

Reflections about the Meaning of Literacy*

One of the committees in any club associated with the National Federation of Republican Women a Federation of Republican Women is the Literacy Committee. Literacy is a community outreach activity for the Active Republican Women of Las Vegas a chance to spread the values of the Republican Party. What below was shared with the ARW Board Members at the annual January Retreat. With the growth of technology and social media in our every day lives literacy has grown beyond what for many years we came to expect to be. Let's take a look at what literacy in 2016 has become.

Literacy extends beyond the print-only world of reading and writing. Literacies are shaped by content, participants, and technologies. Today's context including developing technologies, along with visual, gestural, spatial, or multimodal discourses. -from the NCTE Policy Research Brief Literacies of Discourse

Being literate is at the heart of learning in every subject area. Being literate is necessary for learning to progress through school and engage with subject areas more deeply, concepts become more challenging and adults use a greater variety of learning resources with more and more complex language and increasingly sophisticated graphical and numerical representations. Students learn writing and reading using evidence and reasoning pertinent to each subject area, to comprehend and represent knowledge in traditional and emerging media. -Principles for Learning (2010) ACTE, CoSN, NCSS, NCTE, NCTM

Literacy has always been a collection of cultural and communicative practices shared among members of particular groups. As society and technology changes, so does literacy. Because technology has increased the intensity and complexity of literate environments, the twenty-first century demands that a literate person possess a wide range of abilities, competencies, and many literacies. These literacies-from reading online news to participating in virtual classrooms-are multiple, dynamic, and malleable. As in the past, they are inextricably linked with particular histories, life possibilities and social trajectories of individuals and groups. -National Center for Literacy Education Statement Defining 21st Century Literacies
